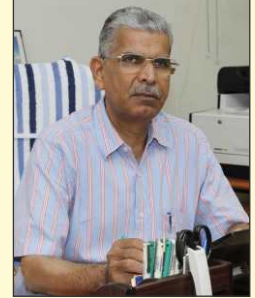

From the Desk of the Vice-Chancellor

Together We Make The Difference . . .

A University is the most potent facilitator for the creation of a Knowledge-based society and thus the most crucial organ for the empowerment of mankind. It prepares, teaches and enables its students not only to dream big, but also provides wings to their dreams and empowers them to realize their dreams. The entire fraternity of Central University of Haryana is putting its heart and soul in performance of this pious duty for the fulfillment of its sacred obligation towards its most important stakeholders—the students.

Making a modest beginning from a temporary campus in Narnaul with three departments offering only Ph.D. courses, Central University of Haryana (CUH) has, in a short span of seven years, transformed the landscape of higher education in the region, ushering an era of holistic development and inclusive growth. Today, University offers B. Voc, B. Tech, Masters, M. Phil. and Doctoral courses in over thirty-one disciplines through its ten schools spanning twenty-nine departments and the Deen Dayal Upadhyay Kaushal Kendra. As part of its ambitious expansion plans and catering to its social responsibility for providing quality education and imparting life skills, University has started School of Engineering from the session 2016-17 offering Engineering courses in four branches: Civil Engineering, Computer Science Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Printing and Packaging Technology. University is also in the process of starting School of Education, which will offer B.Ed. and M. Ed. Courses.

In order to achieve the objectives of ‘Skill India’, ‘Swachh Bharat Abhiyan’, ‘Unnat Bharat Abhiyan’ and ‘Make in India’ as espoused by our Honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji, Central University of Haryana has undertaken a number of initiatives through its various Centers, Cells and Clubs and has also started three B.Voc. Programmes including Retail and Logistics Management, Industrial Waste Management and Biomedical Techniques, one PG Diploma course in Cooperative Management and also a Training-cum-Incubation Centre for Skill Development, Innovation and Entrepreneurship. The University has adopted eight of its neighbouring villages as part of its social responsibility and is proactively engaging with the local community at different levels to usher in a systemic change for rapid growth and development of these villages and the entire region. University has also started a Crèche for the children of the workers at the construction site and plans to extend its facility for the staff and research students of the University and the people of the neighboring villages also.

University is constantly striving to open new vistas of knowledge and employment. Focus has been on developing a 'learner-centric' approach in pedagogy, which caters to the diverse needs of the students. Towards this end, 'hands-on' training, e-learning, innovative discipline-centric and inter-disciplinary experiments and industry-linked project work have been given a major push in the curricula. The curricula and courses are being designed and updated in collaboration with industry partners in tune with Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF) and National Vocational Education Qualification Framework (NSVEQF). University boasts of a rich library with quality volumes of text, reference books and journals apart from providing the entire umbrella of e-resources under National Digital Library (NDL) and Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET). University is a registered partner of NDL.

One of the key focus areas of development at CUH is the infrastructure. All the Departments of the University are scheduled to start functioning w.e.f. Session 2016-17 from its three new state of the art centrally air-conditioned Academic Blocks equipped with Seminar rooms, Conference rooms, a Moot Court of the Law Department, Studio in Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, Research Laboratories for the Science and Applied Science Departments, Food and Services Lab and Restaurant of Department of Tourism and Hotel Management. At present, the University has four fully Wi-Fi enabled functional buildings; moderate accommodation for staff; separate hostels and gymnasium facility for boys and girls; hotline electricity connection; solar-heating facility; on-campus branch of Punjab National Bank and Post Office; University Bus Service; Health and Insurance Policy for students; University-level scholarship schemes like Earn While You Learn and Merit-Cum Means; well-furnished Reading Halls; and Recreation Rooms. Apart from this, the University has prepared an ambitious blueprint for developing its additional Academic Blocks, Administrative Blocks, Library, Hostel for Girls, fully equipped Dispensary and Health Center, Wi-Fi park, permanent staff quarters for teaching, non-teaching and administrative staff and Solar Electricity Power Generating Unit for the University.

In order to provide thrust and impetus to research and academics, the University has entered into various Memoranda of Understanding (MOU's) with different Industry and Research Institutions for conducting collaborative research to explore new frontiers of knowledge. Towards furthering this objective, CUH is actively partnering in different schemes of MHRD and UGC like Global Initiatives of Academic Networks (GIAN) and Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs). It gives me immense pleasure to share with all of you that five of the GIAN courses proposed by CUH have been accepted after rigourous review and their delivery is underway.

The journey of CUH, till now, has not been without its fair share of trials, tribulations and hardships. It has taken the toil and sweat of all the stakeholders of CUH, particularly its teaching, non-teaching, administrative staff and students to shape its destiny and bring it to its present stature. I thank the students, staff and faculty members for their collective efforts and humbly acknowledge the contribution of all the former Vice Chancellors and the University authorities for shaping the administrative, academic and research trajectories of the University.

As the University moves from one milestone to another, we dedicate ourselves to work tirelessly and relentlessly to make it a dream institution and coveted destination for the students and faculty to embark on a journey of self-discovery, exploring new horizons, breaking new ground, for the fulfillment of their cherished hopes, aspirations and potentialities.

The Central Universities Act 2009 (No. 25 of 2009) provided for the establishment of Central University of Haryana as one of the new Central Universities. The University is funded and regulated by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. Its territorial jurisdiction extends to the whole State of Haryana.

Central University of Haryana is located at Jant-Pali villages of district Mahendergarh in South Haryana. Mahendergarh is now a part of the extended National Capital Region (NCR) and is around 150 kilometres away from Delhi. It is well connected to Delhi through railways. The nearest railway station is 13 kilometres away from the Campus. District headquarter of the Mahendergarh district is situated at Narnaul.

The shloka at the bottom conveys that 'education' is the unrivalled treasure of all.

Central Library

The University has a well- equipped library with a built-up area of 3530 square feet. Library committee manages the procurement of library resources based on the needs of faculty and students. Library has 23,811 titles, 19 print Journals and magazines, Manupatra online database for legal professionals, and 258 reports. The library is fully automated. The diverse collections with the update of general collections and subject specified reference work in the library cater to the need of students. The library is managed by a well-qualified library officer-in-charge and able support staff.

The library uses OPAC software namely E-Granthalya. There are 25 computers for general access with 4 printers. The monthly average of walk in is 4194 per month, issued and returning of books is 2700 per month. The ratio of library books to the students enrolled is 16. The number of books added during last three years on average is approx. 1697. The average monthly login to OPAC is per month 400+logins, downloading/ printing of E-Resources is 100. The average download of e-resources is 3000. The library organizes one-week training program per year on information literacy.
